The Moto Guzzi spark was struck exactly a century ago, on 15 March 1921, thanks to the vision of three aviators who had just returned from the First World War: Carlo Guzzi, Giovanni Ravelli and Giorgio Parodi, with his father, Emanuele Vittorio. The oldest motorcycle manufacturer in Europe stands out straight away for its motoring innovations and its industrial vision,

ahead of its time. In 1950, in the historic Mandello del Lario headquarters where Moto Guzzis are still produced to this day, the first wind tunnel for motorcycles was built. A highly successful heritage made up of legendary bikes and a collection of international trophies, with

THE JOURNEY WE RECOUNT HERE IS THAT OF MOTO GUZZI V85 TT WHICH, FROM THE MANDELLO DEL LARIO FACTORY, SEES THE FAMOUS RED GATES WITH THE GOLDEN EAGLE SWING OPEN TO RIDERS, DRAWING THEM INTO AN ADVENTURE THAT WILL SURELY CHANGE THEM!

This bike revives the touring vocation, always a part of Moto Guzzi heritage, positioning itself as a contemporary version of the legend born on the banks of the lake that is still home to the Eagle brand today.

One particular motorcycle adventure that has gone down in history involved the older brother of Moto Guzzi founder Carlo Guzzi. In the summer of 1928, he completed an incredible feat that would pave the way for the 'pilgrimage' that thousands of bikers make to the Arctic circle each year. This man was Giuseppe Guzzi (known as "Naco") who, like a true pioneer from another era, took on the famous North Cape Raid aboard a Moto Guzzi Norge. Having covered more than 6000 kilometres on the arduous Scandinavian roads, he achieved fame







and turned this astonishing feat into one of today's main motorcycle touring itineraries.

Almost forty years after Giuseppe Guzzi's adventure, journalist and engine lover Roberto Patrignani took on another extraordinary challenge,

### RIDING A GUZZI 7500 KILOMETRES ACROSS THE HEART OF AFRICA.

His intrepid route took him from Cape Town to Asmara, with stops in South Africa, Mozambique, Zambia, Tanzania, Kenya and Ethiopia. It was 1966 when this man, a special kind of dreamer, challenged both himself and nature on a journey that was as extreme as it was incredible. In a demonstration of human daredevilry, nothing could stop him, not even the uneven roads - tarmacked sections alternating with exhausting,

bumpy dirt tracks - as he took in some spectacular sights, like the Victoria falls, the Kenyan uplands at an altitude of 7800 metres, wild animals, and indigenous populations who were curious about this adventurer and his motorised steed.

Travel has the power to expand our horizons and change our perspective and outlook on the world, becoming a special kind of engine that can drive human experience. With Moto Guzzi V85 TT, travel, a symbol common to us all, becomes the model for a movement centred around adventure and heroic 'mobility feats', the bike ready to tackle the most arduous territories in the search for its own particular path and personal adventure.

# DEDICATED TO ADVENTURE RIDING IN THE PUREST SENSE, PART OF MOTO GUZZI HERITAGE,

V85 TT conjures up clear images of desert competitions such as the Paris-Dakar, the famous African race that was at its zenith in the '80s. The fundamental concepts at the heart of the V85 TT project, or rather simplicity, ease, and practicality, are typical of the enduro bikes of that time which could do it all, from daily commuting to adventurous touring. V85 will appeal to those who view this ultra-adventurous Moto Guzzi model as a gateway to new and distant lands, reachable thanks to its practicality, elegance, and particularly sophisticated versatility. It is no coincidence that the launch of this vehicle, in the autumn of 2017, coincided with the inaugural Moto Guzzi Experience, an engaging adventure aboard the Mandello twin that guarantees any road-riding enthusiast real emotion as they explore nature, discover the area, and form friendships with their fellow travel companions.


